



## Sports Premium Funding 2017/18

This is the first year that St John's Church of England Primary School will receive the Government's Sports Premium funding. This funding was introduced in September 2013 to improve PE and sport provision in primary schools. It is anticipated that St John's will receive approximately £16,000.00. This funding will be used to develop our pupil's physical skills, enhance their well-being as well as encourage healthy, active lifestyles. We will ensure that the money spent has a long-lasting impact on pupils and that provision made will be sustainable in the future.

As this is the first year we will receive funding, our plan for 2017-18 is being drawn up and will be posted shortly once we have confirmation of our allocation.

Our initial plans involve:

Short term:

- Joining the Watford and Hertsmere Schools Sports Trust at Competition Level. This will provide PLT training, MSA training as well as upskill teachers regarding current PE practice and give children opportunities to engage in inter-school competitions and festivals.
- Funding a quality Scheme of Work for all areas of the P.E. curriculum which will ensure that good practice is embedded and high quality teaching is in place.
- CPD training for the Y1 teacher in teaching and learning as we launch our KS1 National Curriculum.
- Providing transport for our children to access Forest School physical outdoor learning
- Providing transport for our Y1's which will enable participation in inter-school festivals and tournaments
- To purchase high-quality equipment for use in PE and at playtimes in order to engage children in high levels of physical activity.

Long term

- To set aside budget for physical equipment on the two playgrounds in the new permanent site
- To set aside budget in planning for a Mini Bus at the permanent site.
