

Pupil Premium St John's C of E Primary School 2016/17



Allocation:

The level of the premium in 2016-17 is £1320 per pupil for pupils eligible for free school meals (FSM) and for pupils in care who have been continuously looked after for six months.

For the financial year 2016 – 2017 St John's C of E Primary School was allocated £2640. This will be used to support activities to benefit the children to whom it is allocated. As a small school, with only one class of 30 reception pupils and two pupils eligible for Pupil Premium, these statements are written in such a way as to protect their anonymity.

Barriers:

We will ensure that extra resources for developing Literacy and Maths skills are available for home use and that through our school ethos of 'Growing Together in Love and Respect' that all feel safe, nurtured and appropriately challenged.

Approaches and Rationale:

It is being used to support staff costs to provide support for smaller group work in Prime and Specific areas. This enables us to pinpoint specific learning needs and to provide the correct support to enable the best progress possible. This not only includes the maths and literacy specific areas where the development of language skills and acquisition of new vocabulary are scaffolded and modelled. but will also provide opportunities for philosophical, spiritual, moral and reflective growth.

Discretionary activities may include financial contributions towards Eagle Club, school educational visits and purchasing of school uniform.

Impact:

The PP pupils will be closely monitored and tracked. We are aiming for at least 3 steps of progress across the EYFS profile and for the Good Level of Development to be reached at the end of the academic year.
