

<u>Letters and tricky words</u> Give children these letters only to choose from. Put the rest of the letters away into the envelope.	<u>Segmenting to spell</u> Adult to say the word and children to sound it out and put the letters in the correct order on the blending board to make the word.	<u>Blending to read</u> Adult or child to make the word on the blending board. Child to say each sound in the word then blend them together to read the word.	<u>Captions/Sentences to read and write</u> Children can read the caption independently. Adult to repeatedly say the sentence and children to sound it out and write it down.
