Key Information about Class Dojo

- Class Dojo is an internal social media app, only you and your class teacher can see the contents of your child's portfolio.
- The app will be used to share photographs of children's work.
- We will not be using the message function.
- We will be using the free version of the app.
- Please treat all pictures on Class Dojo containing other children as private, only share photographs that feature your child. Please do not share or post pictures of other people's children on social media etc.
- You are able to share your own pictures from home onto your child's portfolio, but please continue to use Google Classroom for all home learning and work content.




