




This week at St John's C of E Primary School, the children played, practiced their handwriting, met a purple robot, had new learning experiences and had an R.E lesson.


















Information for St John' Families

Covid 19

We have had further cases reported in Year 3 and also now in Reception and Year Five. We have a number of staff absences which we are covering at the moment with our regular supply teachers and HLTA's. However, there are still issues with being able to secure supply teachers, and although we will do our best, we are coming close to a point where we may have to close classes if we do not have enough staff to teach the children. A general reminder to all families

If your child is unwell, do not send them to school until they are well. If they develop a cough, please keep them at home for a day or two to see if it develops into a persistent cough.

If your child has a symptom of Covid-19, please arrange for them to have a PCR test at a testing centre, where the swab is sent off to the laboratory for testing. You can book an appointment on this website https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test

If the test is positive for coronavirus, please contact the school office where we will be able to provide you with information based upon the current guidance. Currently this is that the positive person should stay at home for at least five days and only return to school on day six if negative lfd tests on day five and six.

Covid Symptoms

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- a loss or change to sense of smell or taste this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

Lost Property. Please remember to label all school uniform including shoes and water bottles clearly with your child's full name.


There is currently a collection of water bottles, two pairs of glasses and several items of clothing in the lost property box without names of them. Please collect any lost items as soon as possible.
