Responsibilities	<p>Work with individuals or small groups of pupils in the classroom under the direct supervision of teaching staff and provide feedback to the pupils and the teacher.</p> <p>Support pupils to understand instructions, support independent learning and inclusion of all pupils.</p> <p>Support the teacher with positive behaviour management and keep pupils engaged with learning.</p> <p>Support pupils with social and emotional wellbeing, reporting concerns to the teacher as appropriate.</p> <p>Prepare and clear up the learning environment and resources including photocopying, filing and the display and presentation of pupil work and contribute to maintaining a safe environment.</p>
Duties and Responsibilities	<p>Record basic pupil data</p> <p>Support pupils' learning through play</p> <p>Assist with break time supervision including facilitating games and activities</p> <p>Assist with escorting pupils on educational visits</p> <p>Support pupils with using basic ICT</p> <p>Invigilate tests</p> <p>Assist pupils with eating, dressing, and hygiene as required whilst encouraging independence.</p>
